Applicants are asked to write a pitch (maximum 600 words) outlining how their relevant experience and/or qualifications align with the selection criteria. Applicants may wish to refer to the Australian Professional Standards for Teachers when addressing criteria 2, 3 and 4.

Selection Criteria:

- 1. Demonstrates an understanding of and value for:
 - a. MSC spirituality, and the ability to impart it to others
 - b. The MSC vision for education
- 2. Demonstrates a high level of professional knowledge, particularly knowing of students and how they learn, and knowing the content of their teaching area and how to teach it.
- 3. Demonstrates highly effective classroom practice.
- 4. Engages in professional learning, and with colleagues, parents/carers and the community.
